Directions to get to KW and Centre-in-the Square

To get to KW:

We'll drive West down King St E and get on the 403 Eastbound (North really...) we'll exit at Highway 6 and head to Morristown where we will get on the 401 Westbound to KW. After that we take highway 8 towards Kitchener downtown, we stay on it (don't go to Highway 7) and it will become King St. Montgomery Rd is right there (1st intersection after leaving the highway); make right onto Montgomery Rd, then immediately left onto Weber St. Follow that till the intersection with Queen St, make a right turn onto Queen; follow till you will see the Centre in the Square on your right. Get to the Ellen st. (back on the building), turn right and pull into half-ring driveway. Let the kids off at the Stage Doors (big sign above it). The stage door receptionist is selling the tokens to the parking. If this one is full, please get back to Queen st, turn into Otto and enter the parking lot there. All visible on the map. There will be some volunteers at the Stage Doors helping out.

Ellen St. becomes one-way street at Mansion St – there is an arrow on the map marking the direction. The King street in Kitchener downtown will have short closed off sections.

Parking

There is a parking lot adjacent to the building; the fee is \$2 on entry. You will need to obtain (buy) a token from the Stage Doors to access the parking lot. There is also a paid city lot (which will be a bit more expansive) and some free side street parking. There will be no bus parking at the venue; we will direct the bus driver to another location.
