### Stage deportment and movement **\*\*\*NEW\*\*\***

All musicians should respect the ELEVATOR principle. Musicians leaving the stage must be off before the musicians taking the stage get on.

Please, no instruments (unless otherwise noted) in the audience seating area.

Please consult the Musician's where to be when document.

Along with this information, we wish to add the following:

- After the opening piece, a brief statement by HPYO Board or HPYO-ED will be made. During this time, KWSYO brass exit the stage, PHIL musicians get on stage.
- After the Mozart, PHIL winds leave the stage.
- During the Albeniz, Concert O musicians must be backstage to get their instruments ready.
- After the Albeniz, PHIL musicians not part of the Concert O leave the stage, Concert O musicians then join the ones that stayed on stage.
- After the Concert O's 3 pieces, intermission for all, enjoy the break.
- During intermission, KWSYO and PHIL musicians, 10 minutes to relax, 5 minutes to get your instruments to the stage, 3 minutes to get comfortable. Keep an eye on the Concertmaster for tuning and HPYO-MD's arrival on stage.
- In all cases, section leaders are expected to lead, marshal and direct their section's members.
- Have fun!!!

## Schedule for musicians\*

Role call **\*\*NEW\*\***:

- HPYO PHIL members: 10:00-10:15 am arrival at the venue, 10:30 ready to rehearse on stage.
- HPYO Concert O members: 10:30 to 11:30 arrival at the venue, 11:50 ready to rehearse on stage.

Arrival at the church. From the main doors you enter a large corridor. Immediately to the right are the bathrooms, immediately to the left is a smaller hallway that leads to the accessible bathroom. The backstage area (a gymnasium, really) is on the right thirty feet (30') down the **main** corridor. The Hall is across from that on the left, you can't miss it.

**\*\*NEW\*\*** End of show, please leave your music and folders with Nicola and Colin in the designated area. Be sure to identify your folder so that we may return (or destroy) the deposit cheques that were left with us in September. The cheques will be returned (or destroyed) Monday at or after the parent meeting.

## Directions to get to Salvation Army Meadowlands

Anyone who knows the area may want to disregard this section.

The full address is 187 Stone Church Road, Ancaster ON L9K 0A3.

Bus route 43 will take you to the door of the church. The following bus routes all connect with route 43: 11, 20, 21, 22, 24, 26, 27, 34, 35 and 41.

Driving:

If you are coming from downtown Hamilton, head up to the Mountain (Escarpment) and continue South. All major North-South streets/avenues intersect with Stone Church Road. Head East past Upper Paradise Rd. The church will be on your right.

If you are coming from out of town anywhere to the West of Hamilton, aim for the 403 and get off at the Lincoln Alexander Parkway, immediately after the on-ramp, take the first off-ramp (Stone Church Rd) and head East for a few hundred meters. The church will be on your left.

If you are coming from cities to the East of Hamilton, take the QEW heading West to the Red Valley Hill Parkway (south unless you want to go for a swim...) which becomes the Lincoln Alexander Parkway, exit at Mohawk Rd, turn left and left again after the underpass onto Stone Church Rd. A few hundred meters later, you'll see the church on the left.

## Parking

There is a parking lot adjacent to the building. There does not seem to be parking available on the street. If at all possible, public transit and ride sharing please, this would mean more room for audience members.

## Ticket information

For volunteers and working KWSYOP or HPYO Staff: Free admission

Regular audience will be able to buy the tickets at the door or in advance, tickets to the concert are:

- \$35 for Adults
- \$30 for Seniors/Students
- Free for children 12 and under
- \$200 for bulk sales (10+ tickets)

Cash or cheque for payments at the door.

Pre-sale with discounted ticket prices valid till April 29<sup>th</sup>, 1 pm.

Eventbrite (credit card) is available till the day of the show with the discounted price (fees apply).

## Dress code for musicians
